These two programs have strong international partners, University of Miami for the Architecture program, Tokai University in Japan for Computer Science, Duke University in the US for the Electrical and Computer Engineering program, and Syracuse University for the Information Systems program.

All these programs support the growth of women in the workforce, a cause to which Effat University is committed.

Effat University is today celebrating the presence of each one of you and we are very proud to gather these young girls to showcase their innovative and



creative skills through the project competition, and also their desire to take challenges in the scientific competition.

This year's theme, "Renewable Energy", is an important message for the future scientists and engineers you will be.
