I am Dr Haifa Reda Jamal Allail, the President of Effat
University, the first private non-profit university for women in
the Kingdom. In the 20 years since our foundation, we
continuously pushed to innovate higher education, introduce new





academic majors, and strengthen the ties between industry and academia.

We were the first to offer programs such as architecture, engineering, cinematic arts, design, and others to the woment of this country, empowering them to participate fully in the development of the country. We strive to ensure that our academic programs not only match the growing needs of the economy, but are closely aligned to the market needs and the requirments of industry. The close cooperation between Siemens Arabia and Effat University is an excellent example of this.
